International Plastic Bag Free Day is a call for everyone to come together to combat one of the major environmental challenges to eliminate the usage of single-use plastic bags in the world.

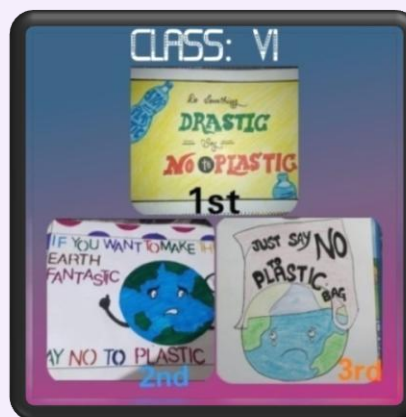

WORLD MALALA DAY

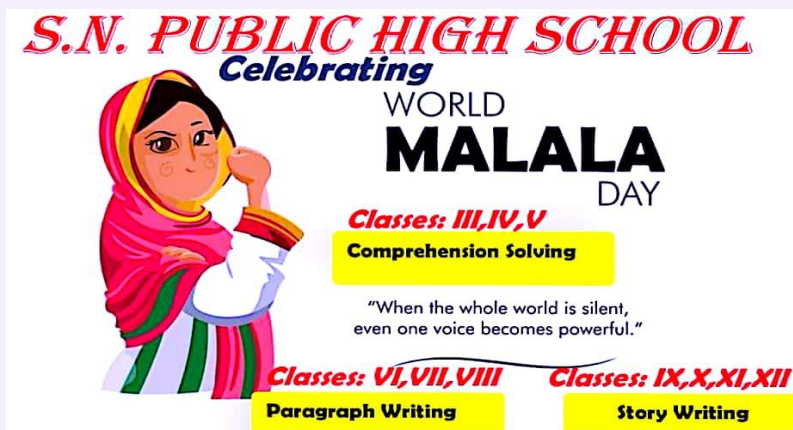
'World Malala Day' is celebrated on 12th July, each year to honour women and children's rights around the world.

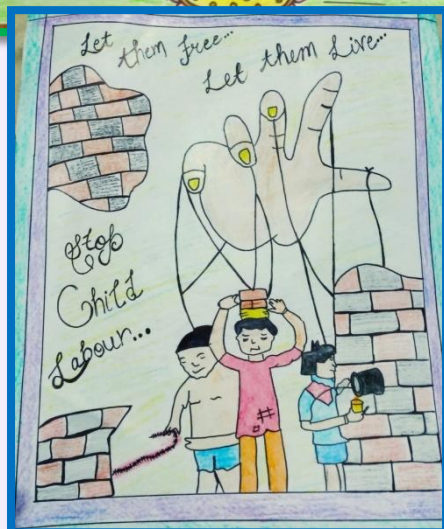
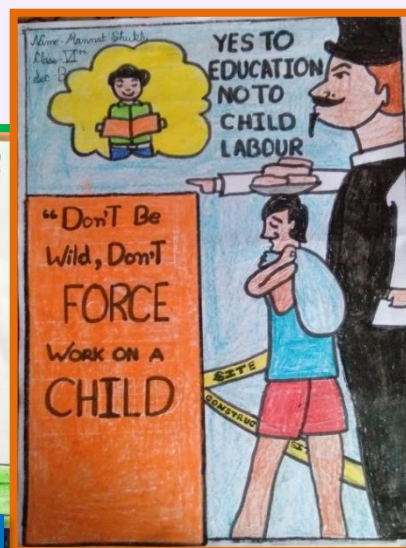
BUDDY GROUP ACTIVITY 1: "STOP CHILD LABOUR"

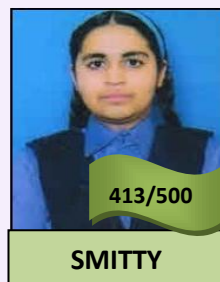

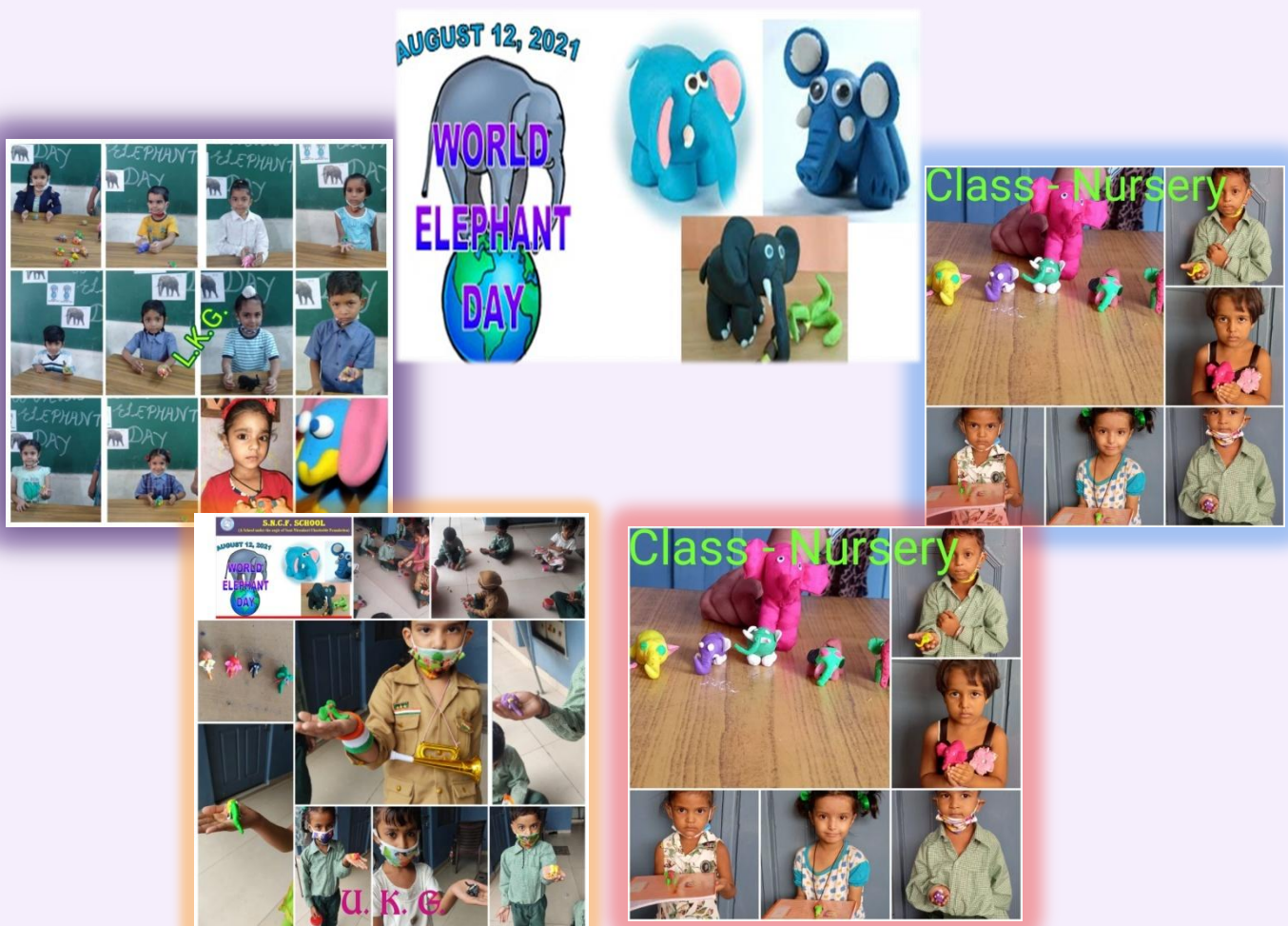
WORLD ELEPHANT DAY

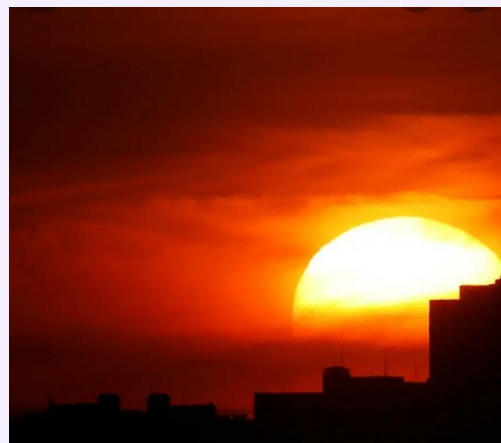

At last teachers & students all together sang the National Anthem & took pledge to respect & serve our great Nation in all possible ways.



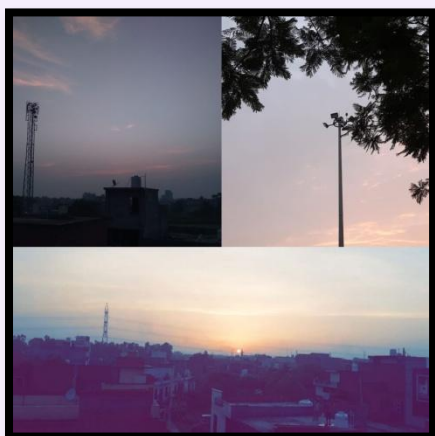
BUDDY GROUP ACTIVITY 2: "PHOTOGRAPHY SKILL"
