A lot of students participated in these activities & showed patriotic feelings & emotions in their poems, songs & other activities to celebrate the monumental day.

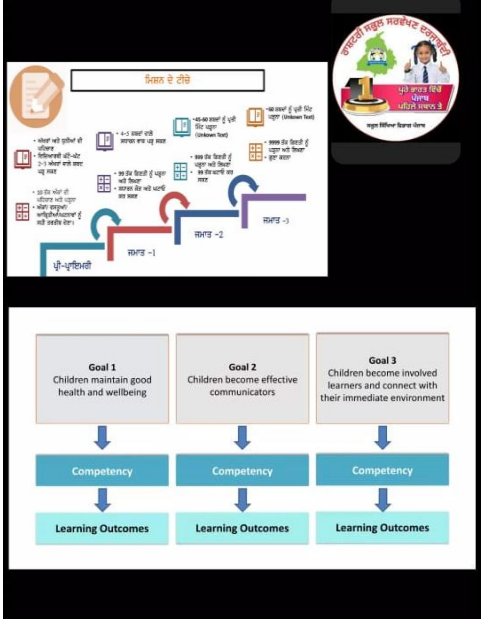

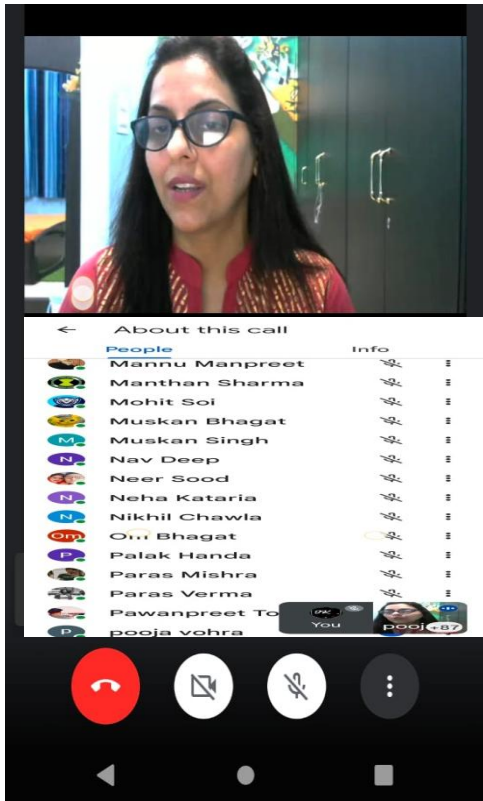


Bid Adieu to Ms. Kamaljeet Kaur
