To acquaint students of Pre Section with easy & interesting craft skills, 'DIY- Paper Fan Activity' was held on July 16, 2022.

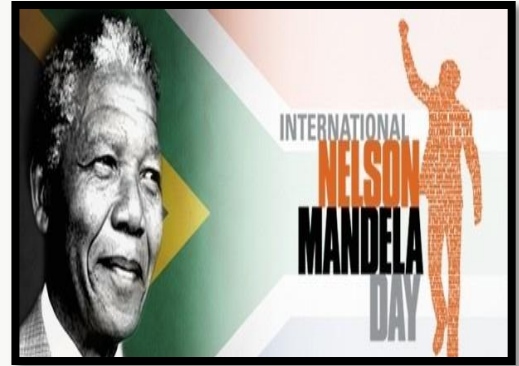

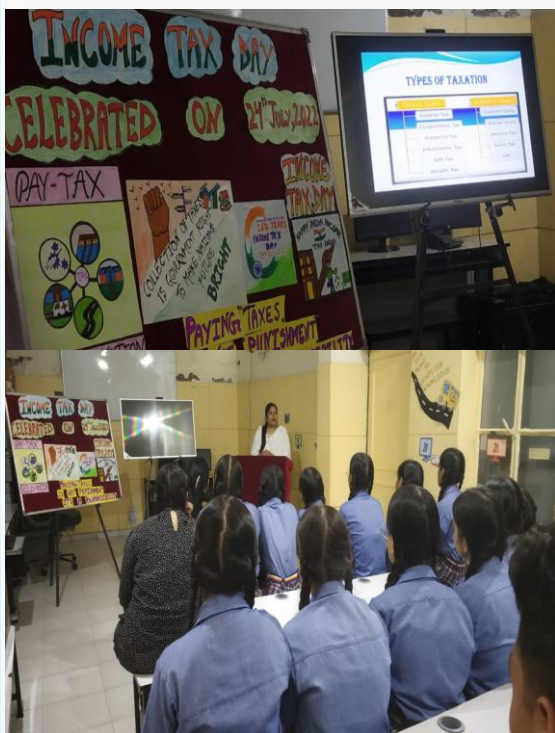
HINDI CALLIGRAPHY ACTIVITY

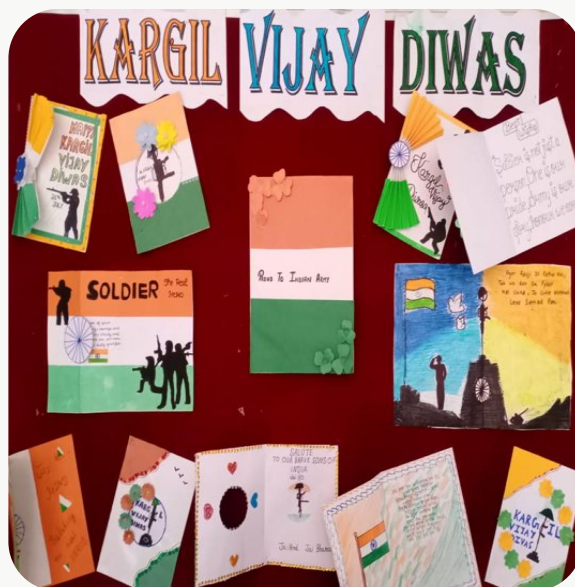
MENSTRUAL HYGIENE SEMINAR
