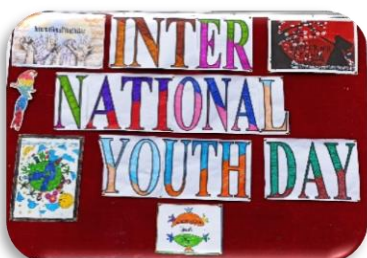

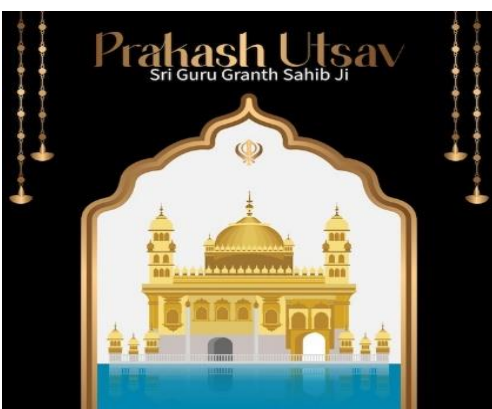


## Prakash Utsav –

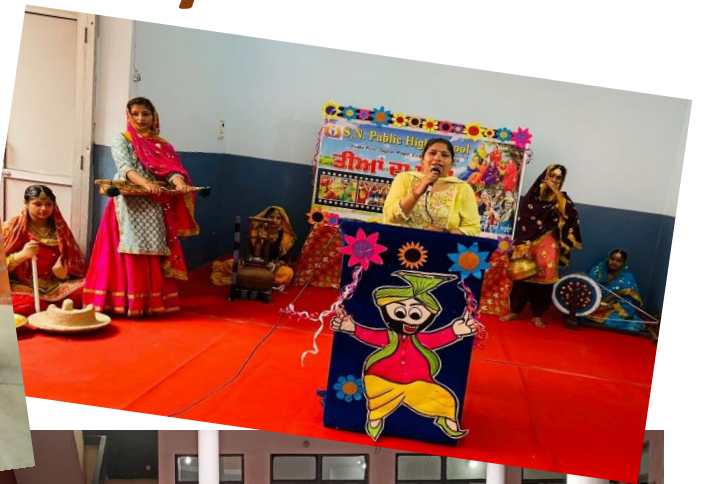


# Inter School Games
