Students were suggested to use Public Transport instead of Personal Transport by Ms. Priyanka in her speech.



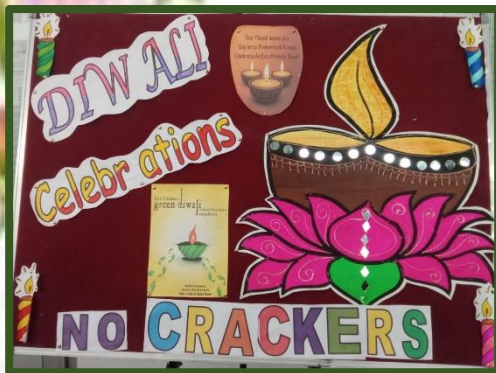
Principal Mrs. Anu Bala also shared her views regarding the importance of Transport in our daily life.

## Annual Function: S.N. Pre School

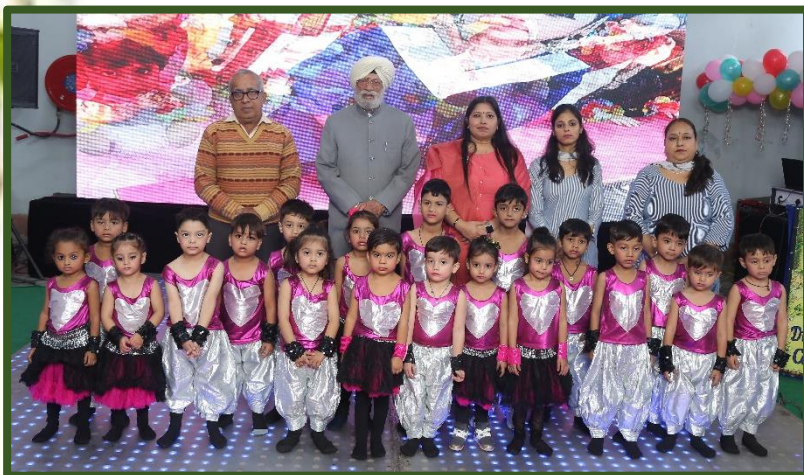
